**EUGENE L. "GENE" TATTINI** was appointed Deputy Director of the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in July 2001. At JPL he is the Laboratory's Chief Operating Officer responsible to the Director for the day-to-day management of JPL's resources and activities, this includes managing the Laboratory's solar system exploration, Mars, astronomy, physics, Earth science, and interplanetary network programs, and all business operations. These activities employ 5000 scientists, engineers, technicians, and business support personnel, and generate \$1.5 billion in annual revenues.

Prior to his retirement from the Air Force and his appointment as JPL Deputy Director, Lt. Gen. Tattini was commander, Space and Missile Systems Center (SMC), Los Angeles Air Force Base, California. He was responsible for managing the research, design, development, and acquisition of space launch, command and control, and satellite systems. The Center employed more than 3, 200 people nationwide and had an annual total obligation authority in excess of \$5 billion.

Lt. Gen. Tattini was born in Madison, Wisconsin, and graduated from Hampton (Virginia) High School in 1961. A distinguished graduate of the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at the University of Illinois, he entered the Air Force as a second lieutenant in 1965. He also holds a MBA from Oklahoma City University, and certificates from both the Air War College and Industrial College of the Armed Forces. He was selected to attend the Executive Development programs at both Cornell University and Harvard University.

His 36 year military career included twenty separate assignments ranging from Minuteman II missile combat crew member at Grand Forks Base, ND to an Air Staff Acquisition Policy Staff Officer in the Pentagon. His oversea assignments were in Wheelus Air Base, Tripoli, Libya and Kwang Ju Air Base, Korea. During his career he was the program manager for over \$700 million in structural and avoincs modifications to the B-52. He was a member of the development team that launched the first US anti-satellite weapon against a cooperating space target.

**STEFFAN TUBBS** is co-host of Colorado’s Morning News on 850 KOA in Denver 5–9am weekdays. He also hosts the community affairs program “Studio 12” on Colorado Public Television, one of Denver’s PBS stations. Steffan has more than twenty years of news experience and returned to Denver in 2005 from WNYW-TV FOX 5 in New York, where he was a reporter/anchor. Before joining FOX 5, he spent six years as a network correspondent for ABC News in Los Angeles. Domestically, Steffan has covered the Oklahoma City bombing, 9/11 from Ground Zero, the Columbine and Virginia Tech killings, the Aurora theatre shootings, multiple national political conventions and the 2002 Winter Olympic Games. His breaking news coverage has won him national recognition in on-scene reporting from wildfires, floods, tornadoes and the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina refugees. He’s been privileged to cover multiple World Series and Super Bowls, along with the Stanley Cup and NBA Finals.

A four-time winner of the Edward R. Murrow award for national reporting, Steffan has covered national politics and is a frequent contributor to the Fox News Channel. Internationally, he has spent time in the Middle East covering Bethlehem and Jerusalem, Pope John Paul II, and overseas assignments in Kuwait, Iraq, Japan and Australia. In 2006 and in 2010, Steffan was embedded in Iraq with members of the Army’s 4th Infantry Division and soldiers from Ft. Carson.

Steffan is a proud supporter of our military and in both 2010 and 2012, he had the honor of taking WWII veterans back to the island of Iwo Jima. In 2011, Tubbs traveled with WWII veterans to Normandy, France to commemorate the D-Day anniversary and on multiple occasions he has traveled to Hawaii with Pearl Harbor survivors to commemorate the attack of December 7, 1941. He ends his show daily by reminding us to Remember Our Troops. The San Diego native is married to his wife Lori and has three boys - Ryan, Nathan and Jake. They live in Highlands Ranch, Colorado.

**TOD A. BURNETT, ED.D.** A results-oriented leader with a distinguished career in the public sector, Dr. Tod A. Burnett has served as president of Saddleback College since August 2008. As president, Dr. Burnett is the chief executive officer of the college managing an \$87 million annual budget and 1,350 employees that currently serve over 40,000 students each year from the south Orange County community.

Prior to serving as President of Saddleback College, Dr. Burnett was appointed in 2006 by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger as Vice Chancellor of the California Community Colleges overseeing strategic planning and communications and developing the system’s first emergency planning and preparedness program.

Previously, Dr. Burnett served two years as the Governor’s Deputy Appointments Secretary where he advised on making political appointments to hundreds of full and part-time positions in state government. Prior to joining the Governor, he was appointed by President Bush as Director of State and Local Government Relations for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency serving under Administrator Christie Todd Whitman and before that was appointed by Mayor Richard Riordan to serve four years as Commissioner on the City of Los Angeles Board of Public Works.

**TERRY O’NEILL** is the Founder, President and CEO of The O’Neill Company, celebrating over three decades providing small to mid-size companies with comprehensive advice and economic expertise in the areas of corporate benefit arrangements, risk management, insurance, retirement plan alternatives, in addition to estate, financial and investment planning services. Mr. O’Neill is an advisor to the Small Business Council of America in Washington D.C. and served on committees that advised the U. S. Treasury and Congress on numerous financial topics.

Mr. O’Neill also has advised two California Governors on economic and business issues. More recently he has been nominated to serve as an advisor on the Federal Open Market Committee for the Federal Reserve Board. He has served on numerous local and national boards. Mr. O’Neill has appeared frequently as a guest on television and radio to discuss the economic ramifications of issues in health care, employee benefits and retirement planning.

He is the author of the book *The Life Insurance Kit* and speaks regularly on economic and financial topics at national conferences.

**KENT W. PETERSON, P.E.**, is Vice President, Chief Engineer and a Founder of P2S Engineering. Mr. Peterson's award-winning design experience includes high-performance green buildings, energy-efficient central plants and innovative control strategies. His vast project experience includes building commissioning and designing, optimizing and retrofitting mechanical and electrical systems for a number of high-profile clients in higher education, local, state and federal government and corporations.

He serves as chairman of the California State University (CSU) Mechanical Review Board where he works to improve building performance on CSU campuses. Mr. Peterson is a past Society President of the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) and currently chairs the ASHRAE Associate Society Alliance, which includes 55 professional societies around the world. He served as the chair of Standard 189.1— The Standard for the Design of High-Performance Green Buildings—an ANSI standard addressing a building's energy efficiency and its impact on the atmosphere, among other high-performance green standards. Mr. Peterson is a LEED™ accredited professional and industry specialist recognized worldwide. He regularly makes presentations and publishes technical papers on subjects relating to improving building designs by maximizing energy efficiency while minimizing environmental impact. He is active and affiliated with more than 10 professional organizations and is a registered mechanical engineer in five U.S. states. 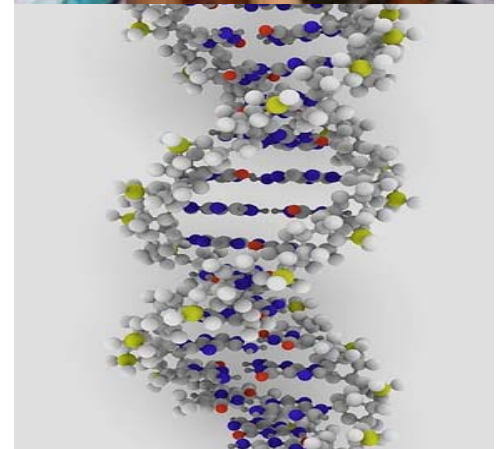
